Since 2006, CASR has been a Rwandan government approved non-profit inter denominational Christian organization with deep roots in the south Rwandan community.

CASR Main Mission:

Our main mission is to passionately preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and disciple individuals through biblical mentorship, and fostering holistic development by positively influencing their Socio-Economic well-being.

CASR Organization activities in details:

-Uniting body of Christ (catalyzing unity among Christian denominations) for fulfilling the great Commission of evangelizing all people around the World and discipling those who believed. This will lead to great awakening (revival) of the church locally, regionally and globally. (Mathew 28:18-20, Mark 16:14-16, Ephesians 4:1-16)

-Equipping and working with student's ministries in high schools and universities for purpose of Rising spiritual and intellectual young men and women who will spread Gospel of Jesus Christ all over the world and influence all spheres (mountains) of world system in Godly way. (Joel 3:1-5)

-Ministry to the poor (helping needy people) as it is the command of the Lord, Working with Government to solve basic problems our Rwandan community is facing with. (Acts 2:42-47)

-Enhancing knowledge, skills and understanding of the Bible to the servants of God through biblical trainings, providing opportunities of studying bachelor's degree in theology and other related fields to people who are interested in learning such courses in partnership with other universities globally. (1Timothy 4:13, Galatians 1:15-20)

-Governmental coordination: This is all about connecting government leaders, business leaders, Church leaders and other influential leaders for purpose of common goal of developing people on both sides Spiritual and physical one. (1Timothy 2:2)

-Ministry Venue: This also includes hosting missionaries and other servants of God with higher Quality rooms, food, conference hall, conference premises at lighthouse ministry center (Light House Hotel) Located in Huye City near University of Rwanda. (Philemon 1:17)

Come and See Rwanda Ministries

1. Department of Evangelism and Discipleship (CASR Bible Training Center)

Overview:

The Evangelism and Discipleship Department was highly active in 2025, making a significant impact through evangelistic outreach, leadership development, and Christian discipleship. Our efforts focused on partnerships with universities, high schools, and local churches to promote the Gospel.

A. University Outreach for Evangelism and Effective Discipleship

We continued to partner with university student ministries to promote evangelism and discipleship. Our key activities included:

- **Monthly Gospel Crusades** held at the University of Rwanda – Huye Campus, either in the main auditorium or the campus stadium. This program was also extended to Rwanda Polytechnic University and Protestant University of Rwanda.
- **Collaboration with all Christian associations** on campus to host and organize these events.
- **Monthly Discipleship Classes** for student association leaders.

Key Highlights:

- **10/03/2025:** A special discipleship meeting with incoming and outgoing student association leaders.
- **15–16/03/2025:** A two-day campus-wide Gospel Crusade that drew many students to Christ.
- **03/03/2025:** A crusade with FAE and Pastor Hortanse MPAZIMPAKA.
- **15/10/2025:** A mega Gospel crusade with all Christian groups at the university, featuring Rev. Antoine RUTAYISIRE.
- **28/11/2025:** CASR, in partnership with the Union of All Christian Associations at the University of Rwanda – Huye Campus, conducted their monthly Gospel Crusade.
- **02/11/2025:** CASR Coordinator Jean Felix TUYISENGE preached at the Forum of Evangelical Associations held at UR Remera Campus.
- **25/10/2025:** A Gospel crusade at the University Stadium in partnership with Christian associations at the University of Rwanda.

We also began partnerships with other universities, including Rwanda Polytechnic and the Protestant University of Rwanda.

Public Talk:

- **22/10/2025:** A public talk in collaboration with the University of Rwanda to complement government efforts, based on **Romans 13:1-7**.

B. High School Ministry

Our high school ministry expanded across the Southern Province, especially in Huye District, where we partnered with 20 high schools (both boarding and day schools).

- **Evangelism Sessions, Discipleship Classes, and Follow-ups** were conducted based on our curriculum, *Basics of the Christian Faith*, focusing on biblical principles and spiritual growth.

Key Highlights:

- **02/03/2025:** A Mega Gospel Crusade for all high school Christian unions in Ruhango District.
- **15/02/2025:** A Mega Gospel Crusade at Gatagara HVP, Huye.
- **02/07/2025:** Gospel crusade across all high school ministries in Huye District, hosted at New Life Bible Church, Huye Tumba.
- **18/12/2025:** A powerful end-of-term gospel outreach in partnership with high school ministries, marking the close of the first academic term.

C. Partnership with Local Churches

We continued to collaborate with local churches and Christian denominations to equip spiritual leaders and promote collaboration in evangelism and discipleship plus supporting them to meet standard required by the government in terms of church infrastructures.

Key Activities:

- **18/01/2025 & 03/05/2025:** Joint Apologetics training sessions for pastors and university student leaders on pastoral care, evangelism strategy, and spiritual leadership.
- **25–26/04/2025:** Pastors' training seminar on the Old and New Testament Survey.
- **10–15/02/2025:** Participation in an international gospel crusade in Kenya alongside pastors from various nations.
- **22/08/2025:** Outreach at Gisagara with local Christian denominations, combining one-on-one evangelism, open-air preaching, and church gathering crusades.
- **14/12/2025:** CASR CEO, Pr. Frank Murenzi, visited the Assembly of God Rwarutabura and preached the Gospel, leading 14 individuals to Christ.
- **14/12/2025:** CASR Coordinator, Jean Felix TUYISENGE, visited EAR Nyaruguru Diocese and preached at the Cathedral alongside Bishop Vincent Habimfura.

International Apologetics Seminar:

- **24–26/10/2025:** Held an International Apologetics Seminar for students from across East Africa. The event attracted over 85 participants from countries like Kenya, Uganda, Burundi, the DRC, Tanzania, and Rwanda.

D. CASR Bible Training Center

In partnership with Global University, we initiated the process of requesting a license from the Higher Education Council (HEC) Rwanda to operate autonomously. We continued offering structured discipleship and theological education to emerging Christian leaders, focusing on biblical literacy, Christian leadership, and foundational doctrines.

We also provided informal ministerial courses in systematic discipleship classes for high school and university ministry leaders.

Key Highlight:

- **18/10/2025:** We held an extraordinary graduation ceremony at the Lighthouse Ministry Center for the first discipleship class of high school students, with 65 students graduated; **The following are highlighted photos of the 2025.**
