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COME AND SEE RWANDA MINISTRIES (CASR)

Narrative Report for the Second Term of 2026 (April, May and June 2026)

Introduction

Come and See Rwanda Ministries (CASR) remains committed to fulfilling the Great Commission of our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18–20) by proclaiming the Gospel, making disciples, strengthening the Church, and promoting holistic transformation within communities. Throughout the second term of 2026 (April, May and June 2026), CASR carried out its mission through strategic partnerships with local Christian churches, university student ministries, high school student ministries, and local government authorities.

The ministry focused on evangelism, discipleship, leadership development, Christian unity, apologetics, and socio-economic transformation. The following report summarizes the major activities implemented during the reporting period.

A. Partnership with Local Christian Churches

CASR continued strengthening relationships with local Christian denominations by encouraging believers to actively participate in evangelism and discipleship while promoting unity within the Body of Christ.

1. Church Visitation, Evangelism, and Discipleship

Throughout the second term, CASR visited and ministered in numerous churches, particularly across Southern Province. During these visits, biblical teachings, discipleship sessions, and evangelistic messages were delivered to encourage believers to become faithful disciples and active participants in fulfilling the Great Commission.

Some of the churches visited included:

- Anglican Church of Rwanda – Kigeme Diocese (3 May 2026)
- EAR Gisanze Parish
- EAR Nyanza Parish
- Assemblies of God Churches
- Several other local Christian denominations like EDENTHL

These ministry visits strengthened collaboration among churches and encouraged believers to remain committed to biblical discipleship, evangelism, and Christian service.

2. Pastors' Revival and Unity Training

On **30 April 2026**, CASR participated in a pastors' training conference focusing on:

- Spiritual revival
- Biblical leadership
- Unity of the Body of Christ
- Collaborative ministry among churches

The training equipped church leaders with practical biblical principles for advancing God's Kingdom through unity and faithful leadership.

3. National Christian Men's Fellowship Conference

From **18–20 June 2026**, CASR actively participated in the National Christian Men's Fellowship Workshop held in Kigali.

The gathering brought together Christian men from different denominations across Rwanda to pray for:

- Families
- The Church
- National transformation
- Spiritual revival

The conference strengthened men's commitment to becoming godly leaders within their families, churches, and communities.

B. Partnership with University Student Ministries

University ministry remained one of CASR's strongest areas of impact during the reporting period.

1. Monthly Gospel Crusades and Systematic Discipleship

In partnership with the **Forum of Evangelical Associations (FAE) at the University of Rwanda – Huye Campus**, CASR continued organizing monthly activities that united all Christ-centered student ministries.

During the second term, the ministry successfully conducted:

- Three (3) monthly Gospel Crusades
- Three (3) Systematic Discipleship Classes

These gatherings strengthened students spiritually, promoted unity among Christian associations, and equipped young believers to become effective disciple-makers on campus.

C. Partnership with High School Student Ministries

2. Ruhango Mega Gospel Crusade

D. Partnership with Local Government for Holistic Community Transformation

1. Support to AMIZERO Cooperative

CASR continued supporting the **AMIZERO Cooperative**, a community-based organization established by the ministry that primarily serves mothers and their families.

Support focused on:

- Promoting modern agricultural practices
- Improving household income
- Strengthening food security
- Encouraging community self-reliance

These initiatives contributed to improving the livelihoods of vulnerable families while strengthening relationships between the ministry and local authorities.

2. Compassion Support for Vulnerable Students

Through its Compassion Ministry, CASR continued supporting vulnerable students by providing:

- School materials
- Financial assistance
- Educational encouragement

These interventions enabled disadvantaged learners to continue their education while experiencing Christian love in practical ways.

During the second term of 2026, Come and See Rwanda Ministries witnessed God's faithfulness through strengthened partnerships, expanded evangelistic outreach, and increased discipleship efforts across churches, universities, schools, and local communities.
